SECTION 1. - WORLDWIDE

BIRTHS, DEATHS & MARRIAGES

International Genealogical Index (IGI) [Births, Baptisms & Marriages]

The IGI is an index, principally of births, baptisms and marriages, compiled by the Genealogical Society of Utah (GSU). Source documents have largely been civil registrations and church registers though many entries come from other sources including submission from members of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints.

Deaths are not included in the index while a small number of entries have been extracted from other sources e.g. census records.

The 1992 microfiche edition of the IGI has approximately 187 million entries. Coverage varies greatly from country to country, and from county to county within a country. In some cases individual churches have not allowed their records to be included. The IGI is also available in the Society on CD-ROM and can also be accessed through the Internet at www.familysearch.com. Both these versions are more recent than the microfiche version.

Events included generally range in time from the earliest church registers (1500's) to 1875. There are some entries which pre date the church registers, obtained from other sources, as well as some more recent than 1875, but they form a very small percentage of the total.

The IGI is divided into countries, with many being subdivided into county/state/province. Within each subdivision entries are sorted alphabetically by name (surname then given name) then chronologically.

Countries well represented include the British Isles (comprises about half of the index), Germany, the Scandinavian countries and United States of America. Many African and Asian countries have very few entries (often less than one microfiche).

To use the IGI it is necessary to have a surname and country and, where the country has been subdivided into counties or states, a county. (This applies to Canada, Denmark, England, Finland, Ireland, Mexico, Norway, Scotland, Sweden, United States of America, Wales.)

For many of the countries which have been subdivided there is also a section labelled "County Unknown", containing entries for which the county or state could not be determined. Some of these entries have no locality reference whatever.

There is also a Worldwide "Country Unknown" section and one for "At Sea".

For countries where patronymics have been used have two sets of indexes - by surname and by given name.

The Locality Catalogue is indexed by country, then by subject matter.

A research directory compiled by the GSU, and frequently updated. While content predominantly relates to research by Americans, anyone may submit entries to the GSU for inclusion. Details of the ancestor being researched, and name and address of the researcher are given.

Cemetery Transcriptions (NZ Society of Genealogists)

There are a number of supplements to the original publication.

The transcriptions include War Memorials and private family cemeteries, as well as some burial registers.

The country has been divided into 18 districts, each comprising of a number of counties. Each transcription has been numbered, and to locate a specific cemetery it is necessary to consult a printed index, which is available at the Microfiche Desk. International Genealogical Index (IGI) - Births/Baptisms & Marriages

A number of sections in the IGI cover Europe.

There are separate major sections for each of the Scandinavian countries: Denmark, Finland, Norway and Sweden. Each of these is divided into counties and includes a section for "County Unknown". Each country also has two sets of indexes - one by surname, the other by given name. This is useful because of the system of naming that existed in these countries until relatively recent times. A child's surname would be taken from its father's given name, with "son" or "daughter" added as a suffix. Thus the surname, even in the direct male line of descent could change each generation.

Researchers in Swedish and Norwegian sections of the IGI should note that for the counties of Bohus, Norway and Goteborg och Bohus, Sweden, they should check both counties.

Iceland is covered by two sets of indexes - by surname and given name.

A section for Continental Europe includes the countries of Albania, Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Czechoslovakia, France, Greece, Hungary, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Medieval States, Netherlands, Poland, Romania, Switzerland and Yugoslavia.

Coverage of former communist countries is not extensive in the 1992 IGI.

The Southwest Europe section includes Andorra, Gibraltar, Italy, Malta, Monaco, Portugal, Spain and Trieste. If research is being done in the area covered by Trieste both the Trieste and Italian sections should be consulted.

Germany is a separate section of the IGI.

GERMANY (GER)

International Genealogical Index (IGI) - Births/Baptisms & Marriages

Locality references use the Germanic states that existed prior to the creation of a united Germany in 1871 (e.g. Bavaria, Prussia, Saxony. Some of these areas are now part of other countries e.g. Poland.

BOOKS

Central European Maps 1832-1870

A microfiche copy of G D Reymann's Topographischer Special - Karte von Central Europa, continued by C W Oesfeld and F Handtke. Glogau, Flemming.

The maps at a scale of 1:200,000 (1cm=2km) were compiled between 1832 and 1870 and where the date of the map is known it is indicated.

The maps cover most of Germany, Netherlands, Belgium, Luxembourg and Poland, north eastern France, parts of Switzerland, Italy, Austria, Czechoslovakia and the Baltic States. Longitude has been based on Ferro (17° 40' W of Greenwich) and 17° 40' should be deducted from the longitudes shown to compare with current longitudinal positions.

There is no index to individual places however there is a map indicating where each map is located in Europe.

Information given in the index is name of head of household, year of birth, village and references to the LDS film from which the data was extracted.

Heligoland 1881 Census

While Heligoland is now part of Germany it was until 1807 a Danish possession. It was then taken by the English who retained it until 1890 when it was transferred to Germany in exchange for some German territories in Africa.

The 1881 Census was not as detailed in the recording of information as it was in England with only names, ages and occupations recorded.

The population of the North Sea island in 1881 was 2,001.

International Genealogical Index (IGI) - Births/Baptisms & Marriages

There are divisions for each province, as well as "Province Unknown" and Acadia (the name given to the area, now in Nova Scotia and New Brunswick, which was settled by the French in 1604).

Provinces are: Alberta, British Columbia, Manitoba, New Brunswick, Newfoundland, Northwest Territories, Nova Scotia, Ontario, Prince Edward Island, Quebec, Saskatchewan and Yukon Territory. The areas best covered by the 1992 IGI are Nova Scotia, Ontario and Quebec.
